ORCHESTRA INFORMATION

An Overview

◆ When are rehearsals scheduled?

Senior Orchestra will rehearse from 7:15am to 8:30am at Boyertown Elementary.

◆ Where are rehearsals located?

Rehearsals will for band and orchestra will be at the same time but in different locations. **Orchestra will rehearse at the Boyertown Elementary Gym** while Band will rehearse at the Gilbertsville Elementary All-Purpose Room.

◆ What if my student is in band and orchestra?

SR Orchestra and Band rehearsals are on separate days.

◆ When will I need to drop off my student?

All rehearsals will start at 7:15 a.m., however students may arrive as early at 7:00 a.m. When concert time approaches, we will have an **after-school** dress rehearsal at the Senior High School.

◆ What is the attendance policy?

Attendance is an extremely important part of a successful ensemble. **Students are permitted to have up to two absences before each concert. In order for the absence to marked as *excused*, please communicate with us the reason for your child's absence.** If a student misses too many rehearsals, we will review the student's preparedness for the concert and determine whether he or she should participate.

SENIOR ORCHESTRA SCHEDULE 2023-24

Dear Parents,

All 2nd & 3rd year string students participate in the *Elementary Senior Orchestra*.

On the back of this letter is the Orchestra Rehearsal/Concert Schedule for the **Winter** and **Spring** season. Students participating in the Orchestra program are expected to attend all rehearsals. Please notify us by email if your child misses any rehearsal.

Please mark all dates on your calendar.

A parent/guardian will need to drop off the orchestra student at the rehearsal school promptly at the specified time.

Be sure that your child has his/her instrument, music, pencil, and MUSIC STAND at all rehearsals. Instruments may not be left overnight in the school. This promotes poor practice habits. Also, the instruments are valuable and must be treated responsibly.



ATTENTION!!!! IN THE EVENT OF SNOW!!!!

If there is ever a snow delay or school is closed on the day of a rehearsal for any reason, **REHEARSAL WILL BE CANCELED.** Also, rehearsals WILL NOT be pushed (like lessons) unless we have closure event early in the school year—then, we may issue a new schedule.

Students need all new materials no later than their second scheduled lesson.

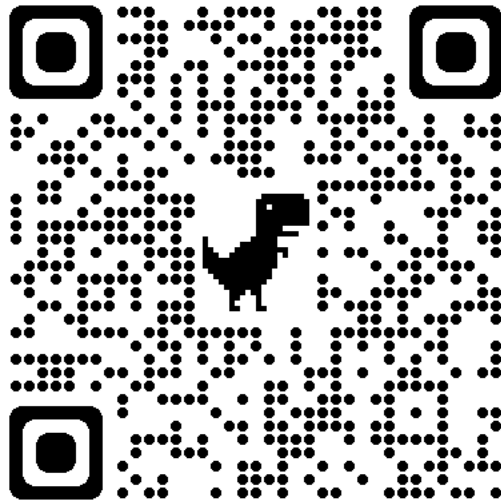
