## An Overview

◆ When are rehearsals scheduled?

◆ What if my student is in band and orchestra?

Orchestra and Band rehearsals are on separate days.

◆ When will I need to drop off my student?

All rehearsals will start at 7:15 a.m. When concert time approaches, we will have an **after-school** dress rehearsal at the Senior High School.

◆ What is the attendance policy?

Attendance is an extremely important part of a successful ensemble. **Students are permitted to have up to two absences before each concert. In order for the absence to marked as *excused*, please communicate with us the reason for your child's absence.** If a student misses too many rehearsals, we will review the student's preparedness for the concert and determine whether he or she should participate.
